A carved fireplace surround and coordinated wall panels create a richly detailed architectural centrepiece.

FAMILY ROOM / ILLUMINATED STONE

Stone, illuminated.

A luminous central panel draws attention to the fireplace, while pale carved stone frames the glow and gives the wall depth.

Carved Details

Layered mouldings and sculptural ornament bring the stonework into focus at a more intimate scale.



Relief and rhythm

Repeating leaf motifs, fluted elements, and sculpted figures enrich the mantel surround.



The crowning detail

A floral crest and curved stone frame give the central wall panel a distinct silhouette.

Ornament carries across mantel, columns, and wall panels.

In every detail

Fine relief and dimensional edges add depth to the pale stone, balancing ornament with architectural order.



Figurative carving

A central face, garlands, and draped motifs form the decorative band above the firebox.



Architectural continuity

Carved supports and scrolling wall ornament extend the composition beyond the mantel.

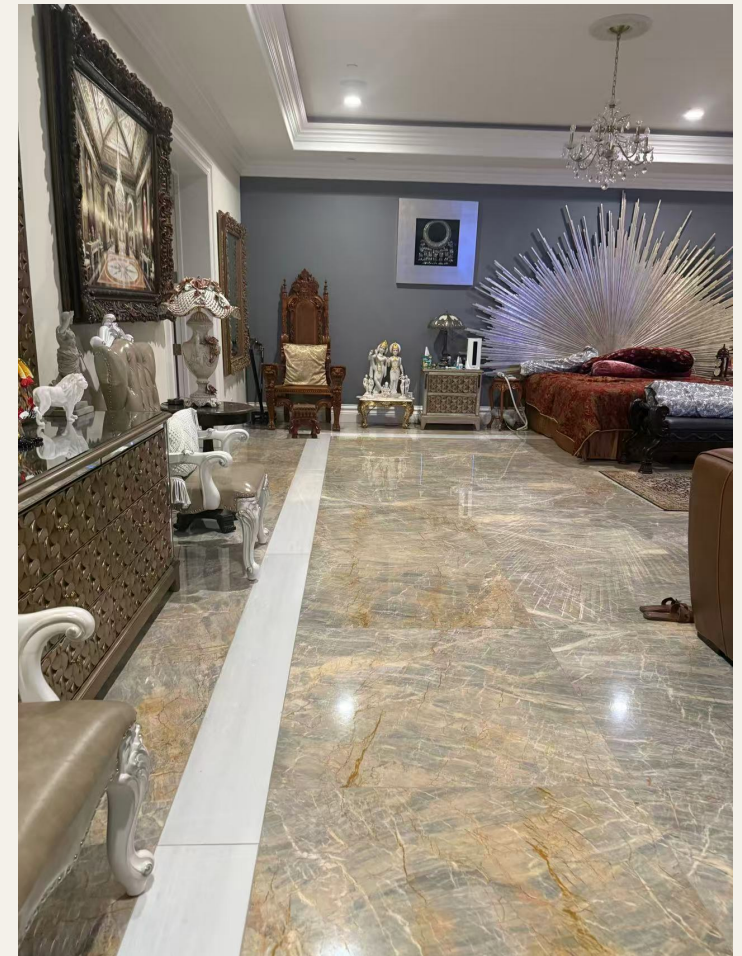
A shared decorative language across the fireplace wall.

Master Bedroom

Richly veined stone flooring gives the master bedroom its own material character. Pale borders define the floor and frame the room.

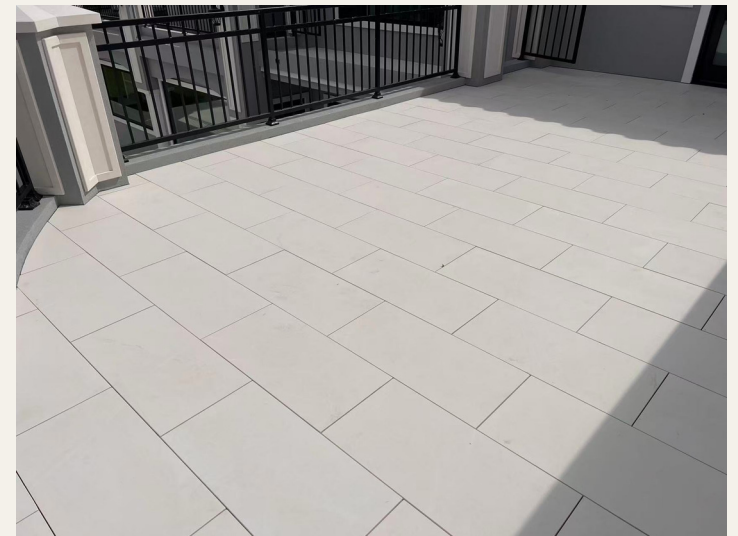

Pale stone paving and broad steps connect the residence to its outdoor spaces.

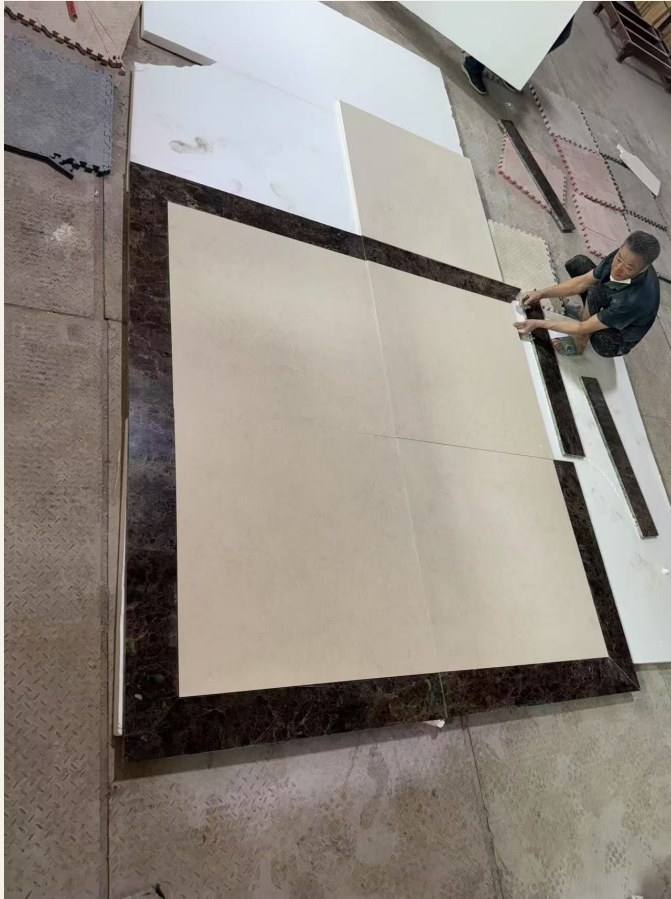


Terrace surface, steps, and paving layout.
